Canada's economy

Canada's economy is made up of many different industries. There are three main types of industries in Canada: Natural resources, Manufacturing and Services.

Natural resource industries

It includes forestry, fishing, agriculture, mining and energy. These industries have played an important part in the country's history and development. Today, the economy of many areas of the country still depends on developing natural resources.

Manufacturing industries

It makes products to sell in Canada and around the world. Manufactured products include paper, technological equipment, automobiles, food, clothing and many other goods. Our largest international trading partner is the United States of America.

Service industries

It provides thousands of different jobs in areas like transportation, education, health care, construction, banking, communications and government. More than 70 percent of working Canadians now have jobs in service industries.

Canada from coast to coast

Canada is a very large country with an area of 10 million square kilometres, but it has a fairly small population. About 34 million people live here. Most Canadians live in the southern parts of Canada.

Provinces and territories

Canada has 10 provinces and three territories. Each province and territory has its own capital city.

Canada's official languages

English and French are Canada's two official languages. English- speaking and French-speaking people have lived together in Canada for more than

300 years. This is an important part of our Canadian identity- more than 98 percent of Canadians speak either English or French or both. You must be able to speak English or French to become a Canadian citizen.

Legal documents like the Canadian Constitution and the Official Languages Act protects the rights of individual Canadians with regard to official languages.

For example,

- English and French have equal status in the Parliament of Canada, in federal courts and in all federal institutions;
- Everyone has the right to a criminal trial in either English or French.



Economic growth is crucial for the future prosperity of Canada, but growth must be managed carefully so that it does not harm the environment. The Canadian government is committed to the goal if sustainable development which means economic growth that is environmentally sound.

Here are some examples:

- Throw waste paper or other garbage in designated public garbage containers;
- Compose, recycle and re-use as many products as possible, such as paper, glass and cans;
- Conserve energy and water by turning off lights and taps when they are not being used;
- Walk, join a car pool, or use a bicycle or public transit whenever possible.

Canada accepts immigrants under different categories and foreign temporary workers from all over the world to meet the shortage of labour due to aging population and low birth rate. This growth has created labour shortages in many of the province's industries.

Temporary foreign workers work in different provinces of Canada in technical, professional, managerial, and trade fields, are able to use their skills and expertise in a dynamic economy of Canada. They can live and work in Canada on a temporary or permanent basis.

There are two Immigrant Investor Programs to choose from the following:

One administered by the Canadian federal government;

• Another administered by the provincial government of Québec.

Each offers business people to provide distinct opportunities and advantages. Canada offers Immigrant Investor Program to investors which provide unconditional Canadian visas / permanent resident status to eligible Investors and their families upon arrival. They will enjoy the same freedom and rights cherished by all Canadians!

Also, Investors and their families will have the opportunity to become Canadian Citizens three years after their arrival. To qualify for both the Immigrant Investor Programs, investors must require fulfilling government's eligibility requirements.

The Province of Ontario

Ontario is the Canadian province with the largest population. Over 11 million people, or roughly one third of Canada's population, live in Ontario.

Most people in Ontario speak English, but the province also has the largest French-Speaking population outside of Quebec.

About one-half of all the goods produced in British Columbia are forestry products, including lumber, newsprint, and pulp and paper products. Mining is also an important industry.

Quebec is highly industrialized and its economy is quite diverse. The Montréal region has been an important financial, service and industrial centre since Confederation.

The province huge supply of fresh water as allows it to become Canada's largest producer of hydroelectricity. There are many farms around the lowland areas of St. Lawrence where vegetables fruit and feed crops are grown. Dairy farms are common.

Quebec has the largest dairy farming industry in Canada. Quebec provincial parks, the Laurentian Mountains and its many historic sites play an important role in its tourism industry. Montreal hosted Olympic in the year 1976.

Hiring Foreign Workers in Alberta and other parts of Canada.

The Alberta Government recognizes the high demand by industry for skilled trade's people and has recently \$40 million in funding to Alberta post-secondary institutions to expand technical training spaces for apprentices in the designated trades.

Canada welcomes trades and other high and low skilled people from outside Canada to work temporarily in Canada and participate in Canada economy.

The TFW Program allows:

- Foreign workers to work temporarily in Canada;
- Canadian employers to address labour shortages by temporarily employing foreign workers;
- Canada allows temporary foreign workers to work in Canada to transfer their valuable skills, gathered in their home country, to citizens and permanent residents of Canada.



Foreign workers are responsible to prove themselves that they are qualified to meet the requirements of the Citizen and Immigration Canada including medical, criminal and security checks. An immigration medical examination may be required before coming to Canada.

Foreign workers, like any new employees, benefit from an orientation to the workplace, its policies and expectations. But the need for orientation does not end at the workplace.



Newcomers need orientation to the larger community, its resources, services and cultural differences.

The employer plays an important role in providing newcomers with some of the information they need to successfully integrate themselves. If foreign worker does not meet employer expectations as outlined in the job contract, employer may terminate foreign worker's employment.

A foreign worker can also choose to terminate their employment with employer too.



We perform the following services for better recruiting services to satisfy employer's mandatory hiring requirements of foreign workers:

- Preparation of client's resume in Canadian standards;
- ◆ Finding an actual job responsibilities of the temporary foreign workers and that must be hands on to get ready for work when they start working in Canada;

- Assessing the nature of the job responsibilities of the temporary foreign workers in compliance with the provincial employment and safety standards in Canada;
- Assessing the language skills level depending on the occupations they will be working on the workplace in Canada. This is mandatory for everyone to communicate and interact with each other comfortably within the workplace;
- Assessing the client's credentials in terms of professional qualifications and experience gathered in back home while they need to be working in regulated occupations in Canada;
- Assisting them to get licensed or certification (if applicable) from regulatory bodies (may be government body or non-profitable regulatory body). This allows everyone to work in the respective regulated occupations.

- They are eligible to apply for permanent resident of Canada after completion of 2 (two) years as temporary foreign workers in any provinces in Canada;
- ◆ The experience gathered must be obtained from the full-time job (37.5 hours in a week) for 2 years;
- ◆ They are not inadmissible to Canada in terms of health, security threat to Canadian society.

International Students are eligible to apply for a Canadian Citizenship after 3 (three) years from the date of becoming permanent residents of Canada provided they satisfy the government of Canada obligations such as Criminality and residency obligations (1095 days) in Canada.

International Students are eligible to work 20 hours part-time in colleges on campus work permit and outside college off campus work permit.

International students are getting part-time jobs in Canada to facilitate their needs to arrange tuition fees to some extent for the next semesters to finish the programs.



There are over 130,000 International students from all over the world study in Canada annually. Canada is popular all over the world for its hospitality and tolerance.
